## **BOARD MEETING:**

- President Monica Asbury called the meeting to order at 10:36 a.m.
- June's Board Meeting Minutes were unanimously approved by the Board

#### TREASURY:

- Jim Miller provided the Board with an overview of the treasury report:
  - Current balance is \$155,555.73. The numbers do not reflect May's Goodie Store sales. The Club has been able to maintain a strong monthly balance since the beginning of the year.
  - A request was made to switch sponsorship fees from the advertising subledger to the Concours and simplify the performance driving subledger description to "Performance Driving"
- Checks turned in:
  - \$6,055.00 Goodie Store
  - \$ 750.00 Concours sponsorship
  - \$ 255.00 Lunches sold at Concours
  - o \$ 925.00 Concours entry fees
  - \$7,985.00 TOTAL

# **ADVERTISING:**

Robbie updated the Board on five delinquent advertisers

- Robbie will continue to follow up on their payments or their ad will be pulled from the August issue of Pando
  - Monica will assist as necessary
- There are three potential new advertisers interested in advertising who will be sent a media kit
- o Mission Wheelchair has dropped as an advertiser

## SOCIAL MEDIA:

- Gary apprised the Board of the following:
  - 950 people viewing OCR's website
    - #1 view is the homepage
    - #2 view is the calendar
    - #3 Concours
  - o There are 1249 followers on Instagram and small activity on Twitter
  - Facebook is a two-factor authentication and Gary continues to work through the challenges of identifying the password and is optimistic of accomplishing access. Worse case scenario, OCR starts a new Facebook page for the Club

# **CONCOURS:**

- Monica provided an overview of the Concours
  - 257 Porsches on the field
  - Attendance was strong all day
  - The Goodie Store had record-breaking sales
  - Some 2<sup>nd</sup> place and all the 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophies had to be ordered after the Concours which were sent to the recipients; there are some division and 1<sup>st</sup> place trophies leftover in storage
  - o It was suggested water be available for sale at next year's Concours

#### ANNUAL BANQUET:

- The 2022 PCA-OCR Holiday Banquet has been confirmed
  - Mark Wallace agreed to manage MotorsportReg once the Holiday banquet is open for registration
  - o Checks / cash will also be allowed to be accepted for the Holiday banquet
  - Parking could be a challenge; however, Tom will provide instructions on parking as we get closer to the event
  - Monica will confirm the capacity and circle back with the Board on her findings and discuss a per person cost

# **MEMBERSHIP:**

- There was lengthy dialogue regarding the New Member Picnic venue, location and member cost, as well as alternatives to holding a picnic vs. a different type of New Member event
- There is sensitivity to hygiene and sanitation at a BBQ
- Food trucks, box lunches, etc. were discussed as options

- Robbie offered to assist to ensure health standards would be met at a BBQ
- It was also suggested volunteers be assigned who handled food to wear masks and gloves
- There was a recommendation to hold the event after Labor Day, preferably the 3<sup>rd</sup>
   Saturday of the month
- Karen will advise the Board of her suggested event and venue

# **HPDE:**

- POC has approached OCR to seek interest in joining together to hold an HPDE on a Saturday / Sunday in January
  - PCA cannot be a 'tag along' group to POC, but rather must be the primary organizer to have access to PCA insurance coverage
  - Per 501©(3) nonprofit organization limitations, OCR cannot generate more than 15% of event revenue from non-PCA members, requiring we limit participation by POC participants who are not also members of PCA
  - Robbie and Monica will work together to secure more details and report back to the Board
- The insurance check for the HPDE held in May should be received within the next week
