he Porsche 912 was designed to be an entry level Porsche to go along with the new 911 model introduced in 1964. The 911 had a new flat-6 cylinder engine, the 912 retained the four-cylinder from the previous Porsche 356, although detuned a bit. Efficiency, low drag, low weight of the 912 made sense, more than 32,000 were produced from April 1965 to July 1969. In the beginning it outsold the 911.

When a friend of OCR member Herb Fischer bought a new one, Herb became immediately infatuated and got one for himself. Herb and his friend have remained active friends for over 71 years and both still have their 912s.

Herb's Irish Green 912 has served him well for over 52 years; it was his daily driver for 21. It was a school taxi,

car for vacations, and performed the utility functions daily drivers must do. It became a household member through family changes, raising children, making one's way through life. When Herb's employer provided a company car, after 21 years, the 912 was gracefully retired to being a "weekender."

You have probably seen the car, it is pristine. Which the 2019 Werks Reunion Monterey validated when it won first in its class. It retains the original sensation it had in 1969 when Herb got the car. He is a unabashed purist, and has painstakingly over the years maintained the car to make Ferry Porsche proud. For any restoration, it is the control. Yes, it has been repainted (but its original color), the front

seats are plump and reupholstered with an upgrade of leather instead of the standard Naugahyde (does anybody even know what that is these days?).

One of the things about keeping a car right, is having a good network of support, and Orange County has a wealth of resources, talk to Herb, you can't do it alone.

For any air-cooled Porsche of the early era its value has

appreciated dramatically over time. It has been a great investment for Herb. The investment is not measured in dollars, but in memories, and not just Herb's but is valued by his daughters who grew up in the car.

Today Herb's 912 shares a garage with a 1923 Ford Model T that belonged to his father. It is pristine, of course.








So if you see a red Cayenne in the drive-through lane this Christmas Eve, you never know.






