



# **SURVEY SAYS!**

n September we surveyed the First Saturday Breakfast meeting attendees. We got 49 responses out of 50 surveys. Here are some top-line impressions:

**On-Line Auctions.** An equal number follow them and an equal number don't. For those that do, as you would expect "Bring a Trailer" was most popular followed by PCar and Mecum.

**Dealer versus Independent Service.** Independent service outnumbered Dealers by 50%. Although dealer service was the choice for warranty, annual maintenance, recalls, parts. An even number were split between "Never" and "Always." The numbers of the split of the survey responses was not significant.

For those who favor the dealer, Circle Porsche in Long Beach have loaner car service by appointment and availability.

**Reading Print Publications.** Most popular magazine is "Excellence." (Other than PCA publications.) Followed by the usual suspects: *Road & Track, Motor Trend, Car and Driver. Sports Car Market, Magneto* were identified but not in large numbers.

**Year of Porsche ownership.** While some ownership includes 1965, the cohort of 2014, 2015, 2017, and 2018 was significant. Several owners have multiple ownership, five was the most noted.

**On-Line Platform followed.** Facebook, YouTube were most frequent but not overwhelmingly. Porschecentric elferspot.com was identified with autotempest.com

**Santa Claus' Wishlist.** Classics like '55 550, '57 Speedster, 904 GTS, 1970s long hood "Polizi" Targa, '73 RS, 959s. Most contemporary wish-list: Carrera GT. But the most popular choice: new GT3 RS.



# PORSCHE 75th ANNIVERSARY Expect the Unexpected

by Randy Leffingwell, published 18 October 2022 by Motorbooks

This book is not an update/extension/ expansion of the Leffingwell's series of Porsche anniversary books an entirely new book with lots of new material from the Porsche archives. Between these covers, the entire history of Porsche 'sports cars' (Cayenne, Macan and Panamera are included) is summarized, from the Gmünd coupes to the Taycans. There is plenty of interest for everyone: the air-cooled vs watercooled types, two-seater vs 4-seater, reardrive vs four-wheel drive, and of course, stick vs various types of automatic from Sportomatic to PDK. Turbo and race versions are discussed separate from their base antecedents, all covered in a fascinating level of detail. The introduction reminds us that Porsche, the engineer, produced a 'Hybrid' vehicle way back in the year 1900; the Foreword by Hurley Haywood gives a personalized summary of Porsche's racing history.

In addition to the cars, many key individuals and their involvement in Porsche's history are discussed. The turnover of CEOs is well covered in the description of the development timelines of the relevant vehicles. Leffingwell's presentation of Porsche's fascinating history from an almost hobby company to a major corporation was substantially assisted by the Porsche Museum and Archive.

There are 30 'bite sized' chapters of roughly eight pages each, tagged by the year-range covered and each given a creative catchy title, helpfully printed for reference at the top of the right hand page. Each chapter is focused on

a specific model/version. Turbocharged 911s have a chapter separate from that of the 911s. The GT1 gets its own chapter (GT2s and 3s are dealt with in the chapter on the base model), but the Boxsters and Caymans are combined into one. The Cayenne gets its own chapter, as does the Panamera, but the 996, 997, 991 and 992 are combined. The text is uses refreshingly large readable type font, and the semi-gloss paper makes the many pictures bright and crisp. The book cover is more elegant than the dust jacket. Front cover shows an overhead photograph of the front half of a '911' (identification of the exact model is 'an exercise left to the student'); the rear half is shown on the back cover. The end papers show 1992 design sketches of the 964.

**PORSCHE 75th ANNIVERSARY** is profusely illustrated, each chapter begins with a full page picture of an representative vehicle. Very few of the pictures seem familiar to this reviewer. Even the pictures of the early years in Gmünd and the Typ 356/1 are different from the ones commonly seen in other books. There is an index so comprehensive that there are two, three-column pages for "Typ – X" entries. There are four entries for Max Hoffman and eight for Roger Penske.

A must have for any Porsche enthusiast and for any close associate of one afflicted with the Porschephile disease. An elegant, coffee table sized book it is well enough written and concisely organized that dedicated Porsche enthusiasts will read this book from cover to cover. It has enough gems of wisdom that those narrowly focused on a specific genre of Porsche will find this book worthwhile even if they only study a few chapters. For those not yet enlightened, it provides a fascinating and readable overview of the entire technical, social and corporate history of a major automobile company and the people that made the decisions that enabled the success. All in all, it is a comprehensive presentation of the story of Porsche automobiles. As the complete story in a single package, this book cannot be beat.

PORSCHE 75th ANNIVERSARY is hard bound and coffee table sized, with 256, 9-1/2 x 12 inch heavyweight pages. The 'arty', photographic cover is almost suitable-for-framing as they say. By the time you read this it should be available for \$60.00 from your favorite bookseller, ask for it, or from Quartoknows.com.







# **Santa's Ride**

he Porsche 911 is an 800-pound gorilla, especially when compared to other Porsche models that have made up the product line over the years.

Swamped by the 911 was the series of front-engine water cooled, transaxle rear-wheel driven cars from the late 1970s to the mid-1990s: The 924, the 944, the 928, and the final evolution of the series with the 968 that was in production from 1992 to 1995.

The 968 is the choice of OCR's genial, Toys for Tots' Santa Claus, Mark Niese. Since 2019, Mark's good nature has been

representing the Man of the Northland at the annual Toys for Tots toy drive.

Christmas Eve Santa has his sleigh filled with toys for good girls and boys. But during the year, for sporty driving around our Santa has his 968. It has a stout 3-liter engine. The front-rear weight distribution is 50/50 for good handling characteristics. Mark has a coupe and a cabriolet. Drop the top on the Cab, and it has a pleasing shape, with the long hood and short rear deck. And there are certain practical reasons for Mark, given his 6'4" stature. He can








fit in it; although a little choreography is required to get in: this body part goes in first, followed by this one and that one, and we're in.

Mark is a regular at many OCR gatherings and events. Most recently he showed his Cab at the White Glove Concours in Dana Point in the "Wash-and-Shine" class. Like so many others, it is an excuse to hang out with other Porsche enthusiasts. And perhaps connect with other "968ers," there really weren't that many 968 Cabs that came to the states, about 2,248.

Mark has had other transaxle cars, a 924, a 944...and offers this advice, "change the timing belt every 30,000 miles." Other than that, and regular general maintenance your 968 should serve you well. And that is one thing every Santa needs, a car he can count on.

So, when you deliver your toys this year at Toys for Tots, say Hello to Santa, you want to stay on his good side.





Reading on a paper media can be enjoyable, especially looking at Porsche things. Especially ideas for the Porsche. Am I right here? As most catalogs have gone to on-line viewing and ordering, I got a nice surprise with a new hard copy of VERTEXAUTO.COM's latest #20 catalog. It is impressive quality and fun to look and go through, even make notes on pages.

I'm glad somebody else realizes Porsche people enjoy looking and dreaming of new ideas for their Porsche passion. Especially with a hard copy where you can sit comfortably, maybe with a coffee or between MLB, NBA, NFL playaction (commercials) and enjoy peeking at what's new. And

there is a lot of new things in the market as well as the good ole great stuff as well. I noticed a larger number of manufacturers making parts nowadays for our older 911s and all Porsches, especially the highly under-rated 944s, and the interest is growing. I was surprised at the number of new steering wheels now available. And old as well as new hard parts that are not so much fun to replace but at least they are available now.

My brother sent me this new multi-use screwdriver labeled (Wera 818/4/1 Germany) that expands and reveals 6 hex fitting tips and has a pull-out green ring that lengthens out +50 mm (2") longer. It was a little 'notchy' at first but that smoothed out right away. It is a quality tool that is very handy for a glove box or even in your pocket? I first thought it some kind of "cheap-o" made over there thing, but the quality got me curious and looking up WERA on-line, it is, GERMAN! No wonder fantastic quality. I should have known, look them up online, for more interesting quality tools.

The new wind deflectors I put on my evolution 1968 911 was to see IF they would reduce wind noise above 50 mph. With my genuine RuF Kevlar CTR mirrors, there is a clear path for air to move over the 'A' pillar and over-around the CTR mirrors. On most 911 & 930s that have those large 'flag' mirrors that disturb the air flow, so they make their own kind of noise? However, one thing I have noticed on my 911 with the CTR mirrors is a different higher pitch wind noise? I suppose because unlike a CTR, I still have the rain gutters on the 'A' pillar. And for the record, the 'A' pillars have 5 layers of formed, highly stressed sheet metal within the 'A' pillar framework for its strength, so you do not remove the rain gutter!

However, RuF does remove them because they first remove the entire top roof of their RuF 911s-930s and build into the bare chassis a special Integrated Roll Cage connecting the 'A' pillar, 'B' pillar, back into the engine compartment and cross over, a span wide with steel tubes. And RuF gets it all installed UNDER the headliner nice and neat and very safe.

Now while the following is no Christmas or "holiday" stocking stuffer, it is or was a need to evaluate for the good of the membership, right? For a constant 'tweeker,' I was convinced that I had to try out an item that has had me curious for a long,

long time. And for us with rain gutters, RuF has a left and right 'A' pillar fillets or "A-SAULENVERKLEIDUNG." These kits fill in the gutter channels to smooth out the air flow. So, I fitted them, then painted, and installed mine with black silicone 'form-agasket' and then the big test: The 22 west to 605 north on a very un-busy early a.m. Well up there, and I'll be darned, it is quieter.

Celebrate our wonderful God, Family, Country, California, and of course Christmas, and that purring thing we drive!
