

Porsche Legend, Myth, Mystique.

his year is the 75th anniversary of Porsche. It is a brand of Legend, Myth, and Mystique. Few are around today to speak about when the company started in 1948. First in Gmund, Austria, and later to Zuffenhausen, Germany.

Porsche Legend is motor racing. The rugged Targa Florio in Sicily and early Le Mans class wins. The most legendary is the Porsche 917, which dominated sports car racing with drama in the 1970s. History now appears in academic black-and-white photos for a modern generation, a long living memory for another.


The Myth is inexorably linked to Steve McQueen portraying Porsche's most famous racing driver. A worried Hollywood studio prevented him racing for real, so he hired the best drivers, bought the latest race cars and went racing with his friends to make a movie. Paul Newman is the actor with racing credibility. He won championships and finished second at Le Mans in 1979 in a 935.

The Porsche Mystique. It endures from the early Zuffenhausen 356 cars. Solid. Handling. Transcendence through the steering wheel. People pay \$300,000 for it.

The mystique turns the sane into fanatics. Collectors collect all red ones, or all white ones, or one of every 911 generation. It wouldn't be a surprise Porsche Corporate harbors a smidgen of disdain for the devotionally faithful, leveraging the Porsche Enthusiast's goodwill and pocketbook.






Iguazu Falls, Argentina



He has owned 27 Porsches (mostly 911s), raced the Baja and other off-road races for 42 years, and has tended to wine vines in his vineyards in Sonoma and Santa Ynez.

Family wealth has given him entree into the heady world of owning some prized Porsches. He has owned them for pleasure, bought and sold them because it

was good business.

Of his Porsches, each one has a story around it whether he owned it for a few years, or just a few weeks to then go and sell it; sometimes when opportunity knocks you just have to open the door.


The Porsche list is long and can fill the pages of a school boy's dream car notebook.

More interesting are the ones he would like back, a popular topic when long-time Porsche enthusiasts get together. Of his list:

- 1980 Porsche 935 K3 that won its class at the 1980 24-Hours of Le Mans.
- 1986 Porsche 962 C he shared ownership in; overall 24-Hour of Le Mans winner with the all-star team of Jacky Ickx, Hans Stuck, and Al Holbert.

The one that draws sentiment is the 1996 Grand Prix White Twin Turbo.

He got it on European Delivery. ("If you get a chance for a European delivery, do it! We stayed at the Graf Zeppelin Steinberger Hotel in Stuttgart. Porsche treated us like royalty.") Leaving the factory, he and his best friend headed to Salzburg, testing his luck at the Schloss Klessheim casino, then onto Vienna. They headed south to Italy, took a right at the light to Monaco and met Michael Schumacher at the Lowes Hotel.

heir grand tour ended in Milan, to go through the Mont Blanc tunnel into France, and back to Stuttgart. (The Mont Blanc tunnel is about 7 miles and is a major link between Italy and France. It was completed in 1965.)

Off-roading is not good for people with kidney trouble, even when belted in like a Navy jet pilot; Cameron has caught air at the Baja, the Mint 400, the Parker. "Hey Maverick, see you in Ensenada."

Dirt has a different meaning when finessing thousands of vineyard vines. Today, his son runs a winery in Northern California's Sonoma County using grapes from his vineyards to produce 90-plus point Pinot Noirs, and Chardonnays.

What is it about Porsches that draws them to him: feeling, passion of German attention, racing, and... the sound.

Cam is a lucky man, he has had great adventures, raced in great races, owned many Porsches and I suspect not his last.



2023 PCA-OCR 51st White Glove Concours

PCA-Orange Coast Region _____

51st White Glove Concours

June 10, 2023. Sea Terrace Park, Dana Point.

Concours events are great for getting your Porsche in order, visiting with friends, and enjoying a nice day. We have gathered advice from Orange County's top detailers on preparing your car.

Concours Countdown.

A checklist to consider in preparation for the 2023 Orange Coast Region 51st White Glove Concours. These are just a few considerations among many.*

Day of the Show - June 10

- Use a door mat rug by each door to prevent dirt and grass getting into the interior during prepping.
- Perform touch-up with spray wax/detailer on a walk-around.
- Use lint roller or duct tape on convertible tops and carpet to remove surface stuff.

Day before the Show - June 9

- Go through car inside and out for lint, water spots, dust. Final dusting with baster brush.
- Touch up rubber trim. Soak towel in rubber dressing for better control.
- Final wax
- Use "clean stick" to remove wax from taillight lens lettering.
- Prep travel kit

One Week before the Show - June 3

- Wash car, start to detail, clay bar the car, wax the car.
- Clean door, hood, engine compartment jams
- Give a careful walk-around.

Two weeks before Show - May 27

- Start with heavy cleaning on dirtiest areas, engine, suspension etc.
- Install and torque wheels.

Three weeks before Show - May 20

- Fix dents, dings, paint touch-up
- With wheels off the car, clean wheel wells. Clean wheels/tires front and back
- Check interior. Clean out stuff around and under seats, glove box. Begin with the center console and work outward.
- For heavy cleaning, shampoo carpets to allow time to dry.

Four weeks before Show - May 13

- Make a plan, reference old judging sheets.
- Consult Zone 8 Concours guide.
- Go through the car to make sure everything works; electrical, mechanical. No leaks, no missing parts (tool kit, jack parts). Paper documentation.
- Organize detailing supplies; plenty of micro-fiber towels (wash new towels to reduce lint). Color-code towels to tasks: exterior, interior, windows. The point is to avoid contamination.
- * These are suggestions made in good faith, we are not responsible to damage or harm in any way to your car.











Streakless Windows

- Use washed cloth towels. Without fabric softener, it contaminates.
- Window cleaner: Chemical Guys Streak Free. Avoid cleaners with ammonia, can damage tints.
- Use towels for inside, a set for outside.
- Do the outside first. Cross hatch outside with inside, makes it easier to identify streaks.

First Impressions Count

Judges have only 5 minutes for each car, first impressions count.

- Paint reflects brilliance
- Chrome sparkles
- Wheels/tires are clean
- · Windows are streakless
- Door jams are clean

In Your Travel Bag Day of Show

- Baster brush for final dusting
- Window cleaner/window towels
- Dozen of new micro-fiber towels (pre-wash)
- Synthetic spray wax/Instant detailer
- Brush for grass
- Mini leaf blower/hand vacuum
- The latest PANDO.

What Do You Get a 911 For Its Birthday?

y 911SC recently turned 40. The time turned without much angst or mid-life crisis.

For its age it looks pretty good. Not many wrinkles, although there's a little something on the left rear bumper guard. It still has its youthful look, and the wheel flares still have a nice shape like when they left the factory.

It was built in April 1983. VIN 122050, an early car in the sequence starting at 0001 to 2559. Porsche made a lot of the SC between 1978 and 1983. It was over the time when the 911 model was going to be discontinued. You've heard that story: about the production timeline that was drawn off the chart.

Because Porsche made 67,472 (coupes, targas, cabriolets) its value has not soared like so many other 911 models. But we are not jealous. Sports Car Market gives it a B investment grade, versus the C the subsequent Carrera model gets.

This car is a California-spec car delivered in Stuttgart. The first owner took delivery while on a Young Presidents Organization junket. He was a Southern California architect and builder, his name adorned a building on Sunset Boulevard, and it is now on a university building. He took it to his place in Sun Valley, Idaho

and I figure had for about 18 years. The second owner, an LA artist, a real artist, not a starving one, had it for about 4 years, sold it to me. (He was moving to Minnesota and didn't think it would be too good there.) It was the only 911 I looked at or drove. We've been together ever since, 18 years.

Over Time, Things Change a Little.

- In 1983, "Risky Business" 944:"There is no Substitute."
- In 1993, Beanie Babies go on sale, gas \$1.11 a gallon.
- In 2003, "In da Club" #1 single, 50 Cent.
- In 2013, "selfie" was added to the dictionary.
