Porsche Celebrates.

his year's celebrations for Porsche are beginning to draw to a close.

The 75th anniversary of the company marks important historical significance.

From a small fledgling company with aspirations to perfect the sports car, they have found not only that success, but success on the racetrack building an unqualified reputation of leadership.

This year is the 60th anniversary of the Porsche 911. Few automobiles have the longevity of the 911.

Porsche Corporate is on a bigger margin kick. CFO Lutz Meschke wants a profit margin of 20%, not happy with +/- 17%. Porsche is making limited production special 911s, mixing and matching from the parts catalog to create model variations to juice interest and pricing

A classic Porsche strategy is the new 911 S/T due in 2024: decontent it (take 70 pounds out, to be lighter than the GT3 Touring MT), limit the production (making 1,963 in honor of the 60th launch year), raise the price (MSRP \$290,000 to start).

Forbes.com is reporting Porsche says buyers of the \$290,000 911 S/T must lease the car for 12-months before taking ownership to avoid speculative "flipping" on the second-hand market.

Yet to be announced is Porsche Corporate recommending dealer's sale price stick to the MSRP, internet rumor is dealers will add another 100 grand markup to the car.

verall, the Porsche market rebounded from a poor August to the levels we saw in July with a 71% sell-through rate, producing \$31,018,453 off 595 vehicles offered for sale. However, some markets did better than others, as the 992 market continued to soften.

GT3s

Of the five 992 GT3s to cross the block, three found homes, and not a single unit was bid over \$300,000, including a lone GT3 Touring 6-speed. Winged cars struggled as we saw the lowest bid on record of \$218,000 for a 2022 GT3 6-Speed finished in Paint to Sample Linden Green with a host of CXX options, and only 1,000 miles failed to sell. On the non-GT front, we saw a well-optioned 2022 91 Carrera S Coupe with a 7-speed and sticker of \$167,000 sell for \$151,000, showing that 911s are starting to trade below MSRP more regularly.

Another market that has continued to soften this month is the Boxster Spyder market, with the biggest surprise being a 900mile 2022 718 Boxster Spyder that sold for \$115,000, making it the lowest sub-1,000-mile Spyder we've seen to date. Following that trend, we saw another sub-1k 718 Spyder fail to sell at a high bid of \$114,500.

Failing to Sell

964 Carrera RS also had a rough go of it, with a rare Rubystone equipped with the Appearance Group Package, 15" Fuchs alloy N/GT example failing to sell at a high bid of \$282,000. Earlier wheels, and a Stoddard muffler. this year, we saw a five-year high for a Rubystone N/GT This example finished in an interesting color combination at \$401,000, so to see this example fall so short was rather and in original condition, brought a new twelve-month high disappointing. Adding to the disappointment was another 964 of \$64,000. Carrera RS that failed to sell at a high bid of only \$153,000. These no sales were more affected by the quality of the cars While not a terrible month, many markets were still far from offered than an overall market decline, as one had paintwork their Spring numbers. I believe we'll see the new cars continue and no records, and the other had an accident history and was to soften through the Fall and into next year while some of our classic models, like the 356 and 993, start to even out and located in Germany. most likely pop back up come Spring. Only time will tell. Happy bidding.

But it wasn't all doom and gloom as several cars reached twelvemonth and five-year highs. At \$127,000, we had a Guards Red 1990 911 Carrera 2 Targa 5-speed achieve a twelve-month high due to its remarkable condition and only 16,963 miles. We also

had another superb Targa reach a five-year high with a 1970 911E Targa with all original paint, original interior, matching numbers, and fully documented mileage hit \$153,000.



The two most surprising sales of the month came from models we don't typically see on these pages. The first was a 1979 928 5-speed refinished in Minerva Blue Metallic over Black leather with Pasha-style seat inserts. The stunning color combination and a recent refurbishment by a margue expert produced a \$100,000 sale, a far cry from the \$30,000 928s we see on our typical auction day

The other was a 1974 914 2.0 in Signal Orange over Brown

Seeing Double.

he ruby is a noble gemstone. As far back as 200 B.C. it was traded on the Chinese Silk Road. It is believed to have protection properties and is second to diamonds for hardness. The most valuable is "pigeon-blood red," a red with a tint of purple. A shade first seen as a Porsche Paintto-Sample (PTS) color as Rubystone in 1991 on a 964 RS. The apocryphal legend is it was from a lipstick.

The color went into "hiatus" until 2015 when OCR member Lisa Taylor was looking for something different

for her "special order" 2016 GT3 RS from Porsche of Riverside. She had a small paint chip. From Rubystone it had become Rubystar with the same paint code 82N; classic magenta with a tinge of "pigeon-blood red" purple.

A bit apprehensive, she ordered it, and waited fourteen months. It arrived with a sense of relief and excitement. It is the only water-cooled car included in the Luftgekuhlt book. The color has been in a renaissance ever since.

Lisa ordered it from that small chip in 2015, nowadays Rubystar remains PTS, but a new variation, Rubystar NEO, is available on the Porsche configuator making it a lot easier to visualize.

For the last few weeks her GT3 RS was on display at the Porsche Experience Center in Carson, and later her 2022 GT3 Rubystar did an appearance at Rennsport 7.

Paint-to-Sample needs a little clarification; at first PTS was like Lisa's paint chip and "we'll paint it." Now there are 130 Paintto-Sample colors to choose from, but if you have a lipstick color etc., you can get it done, but be prepared to wait and pay a high premium.

Porsche must do a feasibility study which can take months. Even though Porsche has developed a special paint booth for PTS, the number of requests could test your patience.

At first Lisa's Rubystar was the only one in the neighborhood (or anywhere) and a frequent visitor to various Cars-and-Coffee's; you could tell, it had the Flying L Racing sticker in the window. Still special, Rubystar has been seen in <u>Panorama</u> and on other models beside a 911.

Selected by Porsche and Backdrop interior paints, there is a household interior paint in the color, as well as a fingernail polish.


Monterey's 2023 "CAR WEEK" feature:

RuFs new "Tribute" is NOT A throwback to old but a refined new approach to a simpler solution with an all new bodychassis- suspension in the new RuF "Tribute". A tribute to the original 911 that was lightweight, simple, and an air cooled car with 2023 technology.

R uF's 60th birthday present to the 911 features a variablevolume resonance intake manifold, variable valve timing and lift on the twin-cam valvetrain, which operates two intake and one larger exhaust valve per cylinder. Cooling air is pumped by a fan that preserves the engine-compartment look of the original air-cooled 911s. The engine block of this prototype is machined from billet, but it's unclear whether customer engines will use this labor-intensive process, or the more capital-intensive low-volume casting.



The RuF Tribute features an entirely new air-cooled engine designed by founder Alois Ruf jr. The 3.6-liter 4-cam, 3-valve, twin intercooledturbo, AIR-AIR Cooled, flat-six engine, which has been under development for two years at RuF, pumps out an impressive 543 hp at 6,750 rpm and 553 lb.-ft at 4,500 rpm. There hasn't been a new production car built with an air-cooled engine since the 1990s, primarily because of challenges with meeting emissions without close temperature regulation of the combustion chamber.

Beyond those details, RuF hasn't revealed much about the Tribute. Alois Ruf indicated that a limited series of RuF Tribute cars will become available, but that the engine needs another two years of development and integration work. If and when that happens, you can expect the RuF Tribute to be a very expensive car. We'll keep you updated as new information is made available.

In the meantime, you should check out the latest episode of the InEVitable podcast featuring Aloisa Ruf, daughter of Alois Ruf as the guest. - *Few words in the car world elicit as much excitement as RuF. Porsches are cool. A GT3? Quite the dream car, with a 500 horsepower naturally-aspirated flat-6 and a manual transmission. But did you know that the RuF SCR has a similar powertrain, though based on the Metzger engine, is much smaller and is made almost entirely out of carbon fiber? Looks like a 911, totally isn't. Then there are the RuFs from the 1980s, the machines that established the brand's reputation as a perennially cool underground Porsche-freak must own. Just hearing the world, "Yellowbird" is enough to send certain car enthusiasts into a tizzy.* - From *MOTOR TREND* August 2023

PS. The RuF Tribute will be in ALL the monthly rags soon with a lot more information.

The 2024 RuF "Tribute" has a drivetrain mounted into the same modular carbon-fiber chassis used in RuF's CTR Anniversary and SCR models, featuring a control-arm suspension with pushrod-actuated coil-over shocks at all four corners. There's an integrated roll cage in case the driver gets things terribly wrong. Curb weight is whispered to be around: 2,700 pounds.

I find the idea of a 200,000 K RuF sports car overwhelming. The new factory GT3 S/T thing is also priced into stratosphieric realms.

For what I've seen for the last 38 years, I would get a RuF Car and drive it for life. The whole of RuF is, is what Porsche AG was like 40 years ago, and it was community. We rather liked being a minority car owner even called a hop-uped Volkswagen; and so what we laughed, but also celebrated placing in the top 3 in a GT race somewhere in the world every week!

The 917 started the steam roller (have you ever seen a real "steam roller"? It is truly AWESOME!) Anyway, Porsche in 1970 onward was on a steam roller quest to nothing but 1st place in everything. Their cars are near perfect and they do what they are designed to do reliably what the designers, engineers and builders created them for.

IF there is one fault, besides price, it is the non-involvement of the driver. The GT2 and some GT3s DO let the driver drive with some over-riding computer functions inop, but the 911 is still a large, overweight car that is still exceptional and always fun to drive.

I'm of the hot rod 911 world dictated by need and discovered early on, there are many of us. Most of us so need to remain in a more basic, lighter 911 and DRIVE it ourselves without computer dictated programing. SO, we have had no choice but to make our own, which in a way is exactly what Zuffenhausen has been doing for 58 years with the 911.
