

MIKE AND HIS 912.

Mike Newlon celebrated his graduation from college and acquiring his first job by buying a sports car he couldn't afford: a 1969 Porsche 912.


Upon his retirement in early 2005, he embarked on a two-year project to rehabilitate and modernize the car using Southern California vendors. Once the work was finished, he took to the road.

As something of a history bug and photography hobbyist, Mike and his 912 traveled "the old roads," not the freeways. As much as possible they used an oil company map printed in 1959. For them, it was all about the journey, not the destination.

They traveled the lesser known old highways, U.S. number 95, 99, 101 and 395. Mike's first book was *U.S. Route 395* recording his adventures driving U.S. Route 395 south from the Canadian border. His adventures include his experience with a flat tire and interfacing with President Bush's security detail.

He stopped to read the plaques, dates on old bridges and corner stones on old buildings. Along the way he describes the historic background of the US Highway System, even writes about when and by whom, the highway number system was established. He felt it was important to preserve the memory of the old U.S. highways becoming lost under freeway construction.

His *U.S. Route 99* book is of particular interest to Southern Californians because the route traveled through parts of greater Los Angeles including Garvey Avenue, Figueroa Street, San Fernando Road etcetera.



It is clear Mike did not do all of his tours in a single trip. No reason for you to do otherwise.

Mike and his 912 stopped at quaint cafes, stayed in old hotels with "atmosphere," more than "modern conveniences." "They" talked to "local characters," who no doubt viewed the strange little car and its congenial driver about the same as they would view a visitation by a proverbial Martian. Mike Newlon's books and series

of magazine-sized paperback booklets document these travels in great personal and historic detail. Of a different world, a world where the travel is the purpose.

Mike's books *U.S. Route 395*, *U.S. Route 99*, *U.S. Route 101 and U.S. Route 95* and his *U.S. Route NNN* are available, but might take a little effort from Amazon, Walmart or E-Bay but are worth it.

Road Trip: Paso Robles



aso Robles is practically smack dab in the middle between Los Angeles and San Francisco. The perfect destination for a Porsche road trip.

Leave Orange County early in the morning and you can stop at Jeannine's (jeannines.com) in Montecito along Coast Village Highway for a coffee. Go through Santa Barbara Wine Country via Highway 154 (drive carefully), then hit 101 to scoot up to Paso.

Paso Robles has come to make a name for itself for distinctive, different styles of wines. It attracts vintners willing to experiment and tinker for something unique. The quality of the soil is different than other California wine areas and that goes to creating wines with a special character.

There are 11 certified viticultural areas and as many as 200 small, family owned wineries. Most of the wineries are along Highway 46 going east and west of Highway 101.

On the eastern side is Eberle (eberlewinery.com). The winemaker is Gary Eberle who makes wines in the Rhone fashion. "Eberle" is Germanic and means "small boar" and artwork celebrates this around the property.

The most picturesque wineries and roads are to the west of 101 on 46. Grey Wolf (bartonfamilywines.com) and Niner Wine Estates (ninerwine.com) are easily accessible from 101. Farther west is Tablas Creek (tablascreek.com), one of California's Rhone wine pioneers. Explore the loop of Peachy Canyon-Vineyard-Adelaida Roads for over a dozen wineries.

The surprise of the central coast is Templeton, just south of Paso Robles. Roll into town and you would think you are in a black-and-white Western movie. McPhee's restaurant (mcpheesgrills.com) has a reputation for steaks. Templeton Feed & Grain dominates the main street.

There are new hotels, Allegretto Vineyard Resort (allegrettovineyardresort.com) on 46 to the east, The Piccolo (thepiccolo.com) is downtown. Tasting rooms and restaurants surround the central park that is right out of mid-America. The Paso Robles Inn (pasoroblesinn.com) and boutique Hotel Cheval (hotelcheval.com) have been around for a long-term and border the central town park.

I know it was in *Panorama* that published we don't get into politics. Fine in personal politics but if you drive a car and especially a Porsche, you are involved in politics! A Porsche makes a strong political statement in itself.

We pay a lot for the privilege to own and drive one of the most significant automobiles ever made. It has proved every critic wrong in every argument against the Porsche concept. For all arguments against the Porsche of its basic concept (rear engine, air-cooling, turbocharging, 4-wheel

drive, etc.,) the 911 alone has proven them thoroughly wrong. The 911, 914, 924, 930, 944s, Cayman - all have won every type of race that was ever thought of.

Porsche, even if nothing else just to prove a point, took the air-cooled 911 turbo and refined it as the 993 Twin Turbo. It gave the cleanest exhaust emission - ever tested with twin turbochargers, CATS, and a Motronic. It is clean, efficient, reliable, and has a flaming passion of extremely satisfied owner/drivers!

They had to reinvent new hardware to test the new Porsches as they are so clean with the car's computers. And the car's computers do a better job of monitoring, advising, and reporting the exact problem it sees, far better than any "test only" smog shop could hope to do.

And the passion for driving one of these machines is way too long to write about. We know how it is to get carried away explaining or praising the fun we have with our Porsches; however, there are those who think quite differently and unfortunately many exist in government.

I'm only saying as a Porsche owner, or a Chevrolet, or bicycle owner, we must pay attention to these ideas that pop up and all of a sudden they get passed off into new regulations without our say or vote on it.

And in regard to this, it is announced that Porsche is quite involved in developing and using a new fuel source that is an "industrial-scale plant for making synthetic climate-neutral fuels" - claimed to be zero carbon free.

Porsche CEO Oliver Blume: "Electromobility is a top priority at Porsche. E-fuels for cars are a worthwhile complement to that – if they're produced in parts of the world where a surplus of sustainable energy is available. They are an additional element on the road to decarbonization. Their advantages lie in their ease of application: e-fuels can be used in combustion engines and plug-in hybrids, and can make use of the existing network of filling stations. By using them, we can make a further contribution toward protecting the climate."

Now think on that for a moment.

If a combustible fuel can be zero carbon free, what's the beef with our cars?

Wouldn't that be something to get that technology up and running and put the local smog shops (bandits) out of existence! And working with one of the ignition geniuses I know of, he has been developing an ignition concept that creates a plasma in the combustion process that ignites every molecule in the chamber, simultaneously. That would mean 100% burning efficiency and zero emissions. That hasn't happened yet.

Then too is (one of my favorites) the Ford combustion sensor that 'sees' the actual burning process, as it happens, and makes adjustment in every cylinder, on ever cycle, as it operates. That too would nearly eliminate any carbon footprint.



There are 'evergreen' developments in the combustion engine and I see it to be around for a long, long time to come. But we must be active, and we do need to be vigilant to not be 'driven out' of the Porsches we love, or anything else for that matter!

Speaking of NEWS NOISE: A note on unwanted noise.

I wrote on my investigation for a less dirty brake pad and trying some out. So far the new MINEX pads work as good as the old R4S on cold, warm, slow, 45 mph rush hour traffic, and after a 'Boost Blast,' up there somewhere . . . my brakes. The whooaaaa down is as firm, even, with very good modulation (pedal feel). So that's 100% good. However once warm, they occasionally made a howling SQUEAL! I tried three different cures; aluminum self-stick foil, stainless steel self-stick foil, fabricated metal clip on shims. Not one helped.



On-line, I tried a 3M self-stick anti-squeal Shim sold through NAPA: (#SK 1299).

I've had them on for four months now so I can't call it a 100% fix, not yet, but so far I only have had "chirps," like one 'chirp' during a drive. Braking is as just as great as stated above. Oh, and my wheels stay clear much longer. NAPA Brake Shims # SK 1299 at \$10.99 each package. These "QUICK" shims may also be listed under the 3M brand number: 3M 468MP.

*PS for the larger front pads (1994 BIG RED Turbo Brake pads) I needed to use 1 ½ shims to cover the back of the larger pad. So for 1994 BIG REDs I needed 3 sets. *2: NAPA costs \$10.99 ea.






